Guide to Resources



- A core collection of over 12,000 circulating and reference books and videos.
- Access to over 26,000 e-books through **netLibrary**.
- Print subscriptions to over 250 current magazine, journal and newspaper titles.
- Microfilm holdings including current subscriptions to over 40 magazine, journal and newspaper titles.
- **GIL** - online access to library catalogs, course reserves, and Your Account.
- **GALILEO** - a virtual library with subscriptions to more than 200 products. Over 2000 books, journal, magazine and newspaper titles are provided in full-text. GALILEO also includes Georgia resources, government publications and selected internet links. The GALILEO databases are accessible off campus with a password. The password may be obtained from the Center Library or your institution's GIL homepage.
- Materials used in conjunction with courses are available from the **Reserve Collection** which is located at the first floor Circulation Desk.

Facilities



- 28 public computers with internet access and CD and DVD capabilities.
- Electronic resources may be printed, e-mailed, or downloaded to disk (floppy, CD-R or zip.)
- Study rooms.
- Microfilm/microfiche machines. Copies .15 each.
- Video players for viewing videotapes.
- Self-serve photocopy machines, employing "smart card" technology. Copies .09 each.



Borrowing Guidelines



All students, faculty, and staff currently affiliated with any University System of Georgia institution have borrowing privileges from the Center Library when presenting a photo ID. Gwinnett County Public Library patrons, age 18 or over, may obtain borrowing privileges at the Center Library by presenting their GCPL card and a photo ID.
