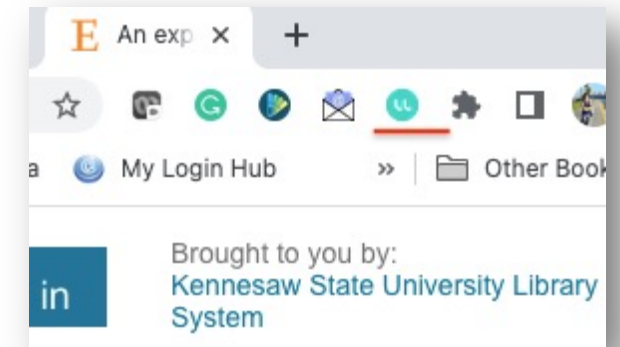


LeanLibrary interacting with vendor website – assist message will appear to guide user to library paid site

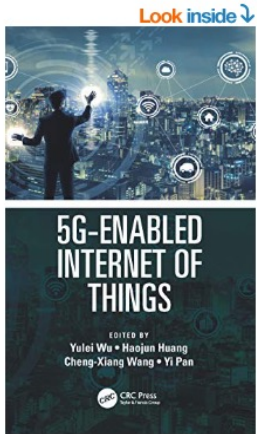

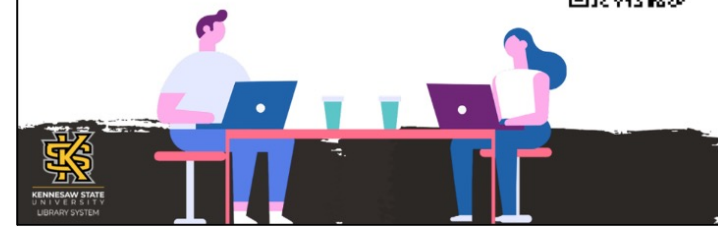

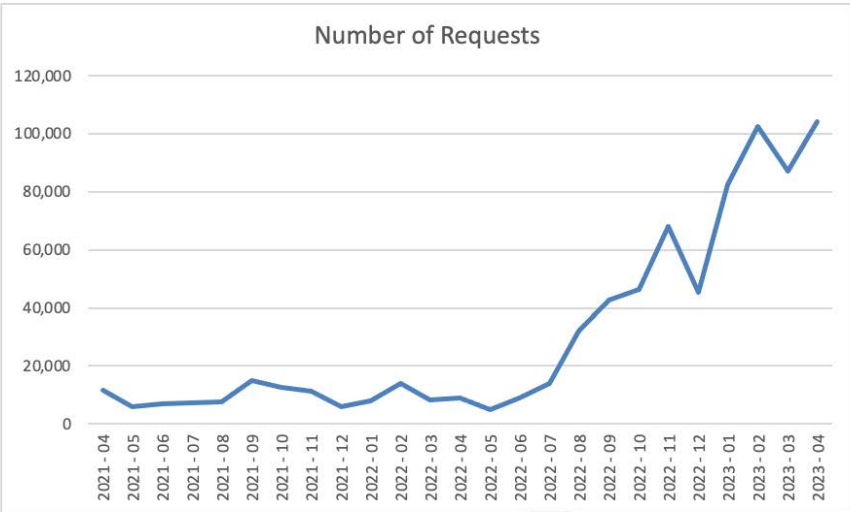

Limitations

- Requires library users to download extension – significant promotion workload
- Can only identify e-resources
- Identifies books and articles by specific ISBNs or DOIs – important to be aware of if looking for an item with multiple editions

Survey Results

User Experience Survey – Spring 2023

- Small survey response (20) – out of roughly 3,500 current KSU users
- Positive feedback
 - Made finding articles easier
 - Hosting resources in "one-spot"
- Respondents reported some difficulty using LL
 - Issues determining if an item is available full-text or not (eg. Linking to abstract database entry)
 - Excessive pop-ups

Next steps

- Second round of survey fall 2023 with focus group opt in added question
- Fall semester promotion event
- Create survey pop-up
- Instructional tutorial
